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Fun Nutritional Facts:

With your children potentially being home more in the summer now that school is out and your job may be slowing down for the summer. These are a few tips to take into consideration.

Happy Endings-Create a routine for the end of a meal.

- Ask your child to scrape leftovers into the garbage & put his/her plate on the counter
- Help your child wash his/her hands & face over the sink, away from the table
- Limit meals to 20 minutes & snacks to 15 minutes
- If your child doesn't eat within that time, remove the food and clean up
- If he/she refused to eat most of their meal, you can cover their plate & put it in the refrigerator. It can be warmed and served if the child chooses to eat it before the next planned snack or meal
- Finish meals together- DON'T make your child stay at the table after everyone has left; finish with your child.
